Why is the Democratic Party caucusing?

- The Idaho Democratic Presidential Caucus is the first determining step in the Idaho Democratic Party's presidential nominating process.
- Voters will vote for two things
 - Their preferred presidential candidate
 - State delegate candidates from their county to the State Convention

When and where are the caucuses?

- All Idaho caucuses will be held by county
 - You will be able to find you caucus location at IdahoDems.org/caucus/
- Every caucus will be held on May 23 from 5:00-8:00pm local time.

Who will be on my ballot for president?

*Candidates have until April 15 to file for the Idaho Democratic Caucus ballot, candidates will be updated as filing happens.

Who can vote in the caucus?

- The Idaho Democratic Caucus is open to all Registered Democrats and Unaffiliated voters
- Same day party affiliation and voter registration will be available at the caucus locations
- Voters will be required to sign a pledge form to confirm that they are a Democrat and have not voted in another party's presidential nominating process
- Must be registered to vote in the county you are attending the caucus
- 17 year olds may vote if they will be 18 by Election Day, November 5, 2024

What should you bring with you?

Printed Pledge Form

- Pledge forms will be available at the location. Check-in will be easier if forms are pre-filled out which you will be able to find at <https://idahodems.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/03/Caucus-Pledge-Form.pdf>

What will happen at the caucus?

- When you arrive at your caucus location you will check in with a volunteer and hand them your filled out pledge form
 - Pledge forms will be available at the location, check-in will be easier if forms are pre-filled out which you will be able to find at www.idahodems.org/caucus
- Once you have checked in you will receive your caucus ballot where you will vote for president and state delegates
- Once finished voting you will return your ballot to a volunteer and you will be able to leave your voting site
- Some counties may have social gatherings or opportunities to get involved in your county party! This is a fun way to get to know other Democrats in your community but you are not required to stay.

Sample Ballot

Your ballot will look similar to this draft ballot.

Please Note: Presidential candidates have until April 15 to file with the Idaho Democratic Party.

State Delegate Candidates have until May 1 to file with the Idaho Democratic Party.

The ballot shown is a sample ballot with fictional state delegate candidate names assigned to their chosen presidential candidates. Your official ballot will have names of candidates from your county.

Please use a black or blue ink pen to mark your ballot. To vote for your choice in each contest, fill in the box next to your choice.
