



**How to become a
delegate to the
Idaho
Democratic
State Convention**

What is expected of the state delegate?

- Delegates should plan to attend the Idaho Democratic Party's 2024 State Convention on **June 22 & 23 in Moscow, Idaho**
- Delegates will vote on party business including:
 - Party Platform
 - Submitted Resolutions
 - Delegates to attend the Democratic National Convention in August 2024
- Delegates will also have the opportunity to attend events and trainings during the state convention!

How to be elected as a delegate

- Fill out the state delegate declaration of candidacy form at idahodemocrats.org/2024delegate
 - The deadline to qualify for the ballot is May 1
- Show up to your county caucus on May 23, 5-8pm, and vote for yourself on the ballot!
- Delegates must receive at least one vote on the ballot
- Delegate positions will be awarded based on number of votes

Qualifications to become a state delegate

- All delegates must be registered Democrats
- Candidates must fill out the declaration of candidacy by May 1 at 5:00pm to be included on the ballot for the 2024 Idaho Democratic Caucus
- Candidates must reside in the county they have filed to represent as a delegate and must be registered to vote
- 17 year olds will be permitted to serve as delegates if they will be 18 by the next general election on November 5, 2024

What does it mean to “commit” to a presidential candidate

When you file to become a state delegate you will be asked to “pledge your support” to a presidential candidate and your name will appear on the ballot as a delegate for that candidate.

Delegates are pledged to presidential candidates for the purpose of representing their chosen candidate at the state convention and electing their National Delegates to the National Conventions.

Delegates will be allocated proportional to presidential results and a presidential candidate must receive at least 15% of the vote to be allocated any state delegates.

If you file as a delegate pledged to a candidate that does not receive at least 15% of the vote during the caucus on May 23 you will not be elected as delegate, even if you receive enough votes.

Estimated Costs

State convention will begin around 9am on June 22 and will end in the evening of June 23

Accommodations (3 nights)	\$300-\$500
Travel to Moscow	All travel will vary based on county of origin and mode of travel
IDP Meals/Events (optional)	\$200
Incidentals (approx)	\$200

Please note: All costs are estimated based on room block prices and all event prices set by the Idaho Democratic Party. Delegates are not required to attend events or stay in the room block acquired by the state party but have the option to utilize it. The state party is not responsible for booking delegate accommodations or travel. Costs are subject to change.

Difference between a state and national delegate

State Delegate

- Elected by caucus voters on May 23, 2024
- Expected to participate in the Idaho Democratic State Convention on June 22-23, 2024
- Will vote on state party business such as party platform, resolutions and the election of the National Delegation
- Must be Registered Democrats
- Delegates will be allocated by county
- 482 delegate positions available

National Delegate

- Elected by the state delegates on June 22
- Expected to participate in the national convention August 19-22, 2024
- 23 delegate positions and 2 alternate positions are available and equally split based on gender
