



## **2024 IDP Fall Semester Campus Fellowship**

### **Participating schools BSU, ISU, U of I, LCSC**

#### **Description:**

The Idaho Democratic Party are looking for students and interested young people to participate in field operations.

The ideal candidate will be committed to effecting change in red states, is goal-oriented, eager to learn, and interested in encouraging Idaho Citizens, registered voters and Democrats to volunteer! No prior campaign or field experience is required to apply. The field fellowship position is designed to teach Young Democrats transferable skills to any future career, but especially in Idaho Democratic politics.

The field fellow will work part-time, for a 10 week term. Field fellows will be paid twice per month at a rate of \$15/hour and reimbursed as necessary for supplies.

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Start (if necessary), build and maintain an active Democratic club on campus
- Hold Voter registration events around campus
- Hold club meetings throughout the semester
  - Let students know about Democratic candidates and nearby events
- Maintain an active social media presence of the club online
- Attend weekly meetings with the Field Director and fellows from other schools

#### **Qualifications:**

- Positive attitude and strong work ethic.
- Ability to complete assigned tasks in a specified timeframe.
- Able to contribute to an anti-racist and inclusive work environment.
- Willingness to learn new skills and ask for help to gain understanding.

- High levels of organization and task management.
- Verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to speak with voters across the political spectrum.

**Expected Outcomes:**

The field fellow program is designed to teach the fundamentals of political field work. In this program you will learn:

- A basic understanding of the voter database.
- Skills to execute a field strategy to increase voter turnout.
- Methods to effectively recruit, manage, and train campaign volunteers.
- An understanding of true community organizing and power building.
- How to work alongside Idaho Democratic Party staff to brainstorm ideas, execute plans, and meet organizational goals.
- Political experience that can be used in future positions within the party and campaigns.
